Farrah Fawcett Tribute

TV1 and Bowel Cancer Australia (BCA) will pay tribute to film and television actress Farrah Fawcett who died at age 62 after a long and public battle with cancer.

The former 'Charlie's Angel' was diagnosed with anal cancer in 2006, which was treated with radiation and chemotherapy in May 2007, but it spread to her liver as stage IV cancer, eventually claiming her life.

In tribute to Farrah Fawcett, TV1 is running a special memorial 60 second tribute throughout their normal programming this coming week.

It will honour the iconic actress and call for viewers to donate to Bowel Cancer Australia.

TV1 have also dropped regular programming to screen the classic Farrah episode of Charlie's Angels, 'Angels on Wheels,' at 7.30pm on Saturday, 27 June.
